



# FIVE CANYONS

## *Tennis & Sport Court - Rules and Regulations*

Approved 8/98, Amended 4/00

***The Association assumes no liability for any personal injury, loss of property or damage to property.***

### **A. ELIGIBILITY AND HOURS**

1. Tennis and Sport Court Hours: 7 days a week from 7:00 a.m. to dark.
2. No member will be allowed to enter the tennis and sport court area without his or her member key. Please note that there is a [\$50.00] key replacement fee.
3. Each residence may have up to three (3) guests in the tennis courts and up to five (5) guests for the sport court. The resident must be present with their guests and is responsible to ensure their guests obey the Rules.
4. Entrance to the sports courts may be denied for any of the following reasons: drunkenness, erratic behavior, privileges previously revoked, delinquent association fees or association liens on member.
5. *Any person whose actions cause the closure or interruption of the tennis or sport court areas (or any damage thereto) is subject to a special assessment for costs incurred and penalty assessments*

### **B. SAFETY REGULATIONS**

The tennis courts are surfaced with a special soft surface that is excellent for tennis, but can be damaged when abused. Please observe the following rules:

1. Please observe proper tennis etiquette:
  - (a) Consider other players when entering courts or retrieving balls;
  - (b) No Swearing;
  - (c) No excessive noise; no radios, stereos, or boom boxes
  - (d) No racket throwing allowed.
2. Please clean mud and rocks from shoes before entering courts.
3. No bicycles, tricycles, skateboards, roller blades, skates, scooters, baby strollers or pets are allowed.
4. No chairs of any kind allowed inside the fenced court area.
5. No canned beverages or glass containers inside the fenced court area, as spilled drinks stain the surface. No gum is allowed while on the sports courts.
6. No climbing, sitting or hanging permitted on any of the court equipment.

### C. GENERAL POLICIES

1. When other players are waiting, tennis court play is to be limited to 1 hour for singles and 1 hour 30 minutes for doubles.
  - (a) *Weekday Play (until 5:00 pm): Adults and Juniors (under age 18) have use of tennis courts and have the same waiting priority.*
  - (b) *Weekdays after 5:00 pm, Weekends, and Holidays: Juniors must relinquish courts to waiting Adults unless playing with an adult resident..*
2. Resident and their guests are limited to one court when others are waiting.
3. When using the sports courts, be sure to limit playtime if another group is waiting or for basketball use, allow for challenge play.
4. Lock the gates after entering or leaving all courts.
5. The tennis and sport courts may be closed at any time due to safety reasons, necessary repairs or maintenance.
6. **Dress Policy:** The courts become soft when hot and can be damaged easily; therefore, only tennis type shoes on the tennis court surface and appropriate sports shoes on the sports court are permitted.
7. **Smoking Policy:** Smoking is prohibited in the tennis and sports courts.
8. **Drinking Policy:** Consumption of alcoholic beverages in the sports courts is prohibited. No glass containers allowed.
9. **Parents Responsibility:** Be sure your children understand these rules before allowing them to use the key for the tennis and sport courts.
10. Violations of any of the rules or regulations may result in a fine and/or loss of tennis privileges.

### D. SCHEDULED COURT TIME

1. Organized tennis or basketball activities (leagues, ladder, tournaments, lessons, or team practices) must have prior Board approval.
